Proceedings: INTERIM STATUS CONFERENCE

The case is called and counsel state their appearances.

The Court indicates its tentative ruling to deny the government's motion to disqualify Patricia L. Glaser. The ruling is conditioned on the Court's receipt of acceptable declarations of counsel and a detailed written waiver from Mr. Christensen.

The Court grants Mr. Christensen's motion to sever. Mr. Christensen agrees to waive his speedy trial rights to a time to be specified on the record at a future hearing. Mr. Christensen's

motion to continue is moot. The government need not respond to Mr. Christensen's motions in limine at this time.

The government is to provide all required information pursuant to Rule 16(a)(1)(G) of the Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure no later than February 22, 2008. Defendants need not cross-examine Mr. Edwards or his replacement earlier than March 21, 2008.

All counsel are to comply with their discovery obligations.

After considering the pleadings filed by counsel and statements on the record, the Court finds, for the reasons stated more specifically in the court reporter's transcript, that all defense counsel will be able to provide effective assistance of counsel for their clients by the present trial date of February 27, 2008. All motions to continue the trial date are therefore denied.

Further discussions are held as more particularly reflected in the court reporter's transcript.

Counsel and parties are ordered to appear in Courtroom 890 on February 21, 2008 at 8:45 a.m.
